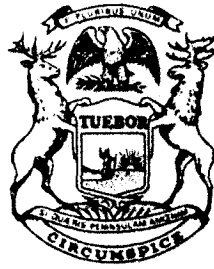


Janet Callahan Barnes has been in private practice since 1981 and with the firm of Secrest Wardle continuously since 1986; and,


Janet Callahan Barnes has been counsel on 432 cases in the Court of Appeals and on 118 cases in the Supreme Court since 1986; and,


Janet Callahan Barnes has decided to retire from the active practice of law on June 18, 2010; therefore,




